



Thank you for choosing Casa Viva Troncones for your next holiday getaway. For your convenience we've put together this printable document with useful information you can print and take with you. Included are:

Basic Information:

The closest airport to Casa Viva is Ixtapa/Zihuatanejo (ZIH). From there it is about a 30-minute drive to Troncones Beach. Any Taxi from the Airport knows their way to Troncones. Last time we checked, Taxi's cost about \$60 (US Dollars) for one-way fare to Troncones.

You can rent a car, with rates on the spot costing about \$100 per day for a jeep; you may be able to negotiate a better rate in advance. Most major car rental agencies operate out of ZIH airport including Hertz and Budget.

We suggest you stop at La Comercial Mexicana (see Map below) in Zihuatanejo, on your way to Troncones. That is the big shopping market (Walmart meets modern grocery store – they have everything) where you can find anything from fresh groceries to that extra bathing suit you forgot. If you are more adventurous, our favorite place is the fresh market (Mercado) located in downtown Zihuatanejo, good for foodstuff as well as the best deal in local souvenirs.

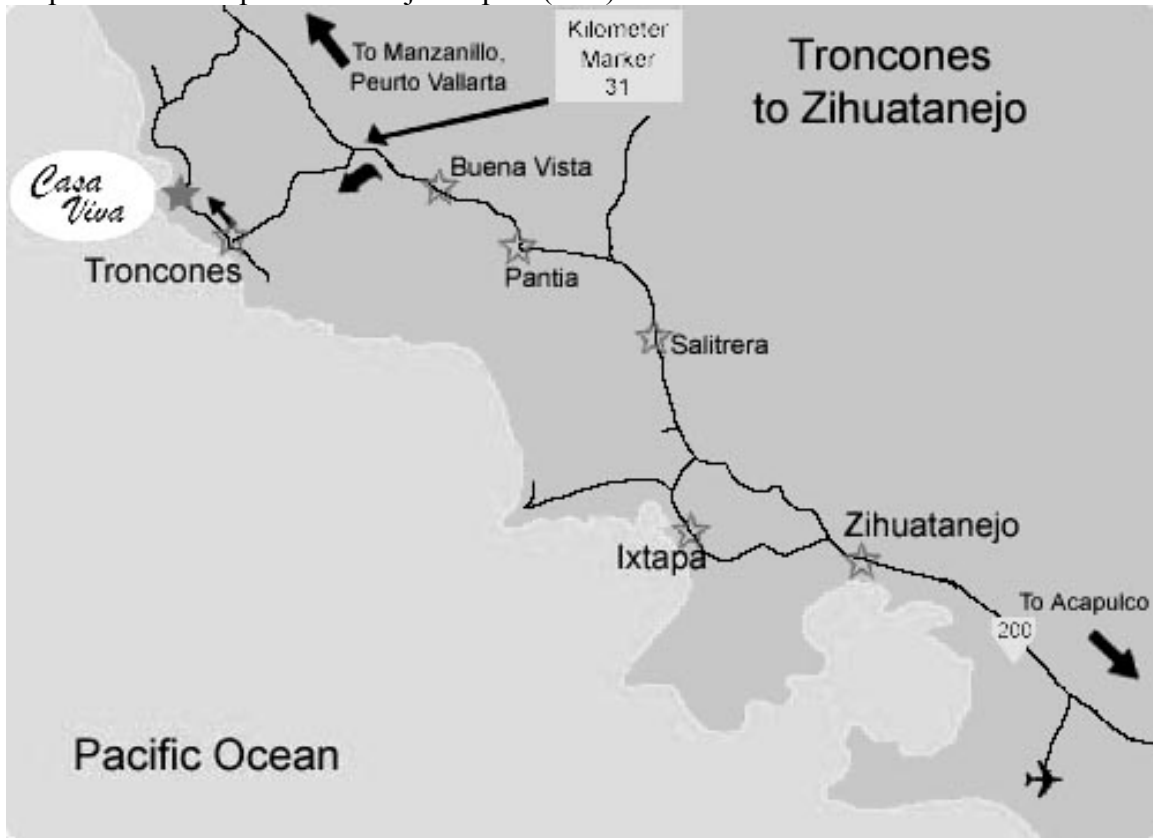
Buy all you need, since Casa Viva has 3 full refrigerators. Food will not go to waste.

Driving Directions from the Ixtapa/Zihuatanejo Airport (ZIH):

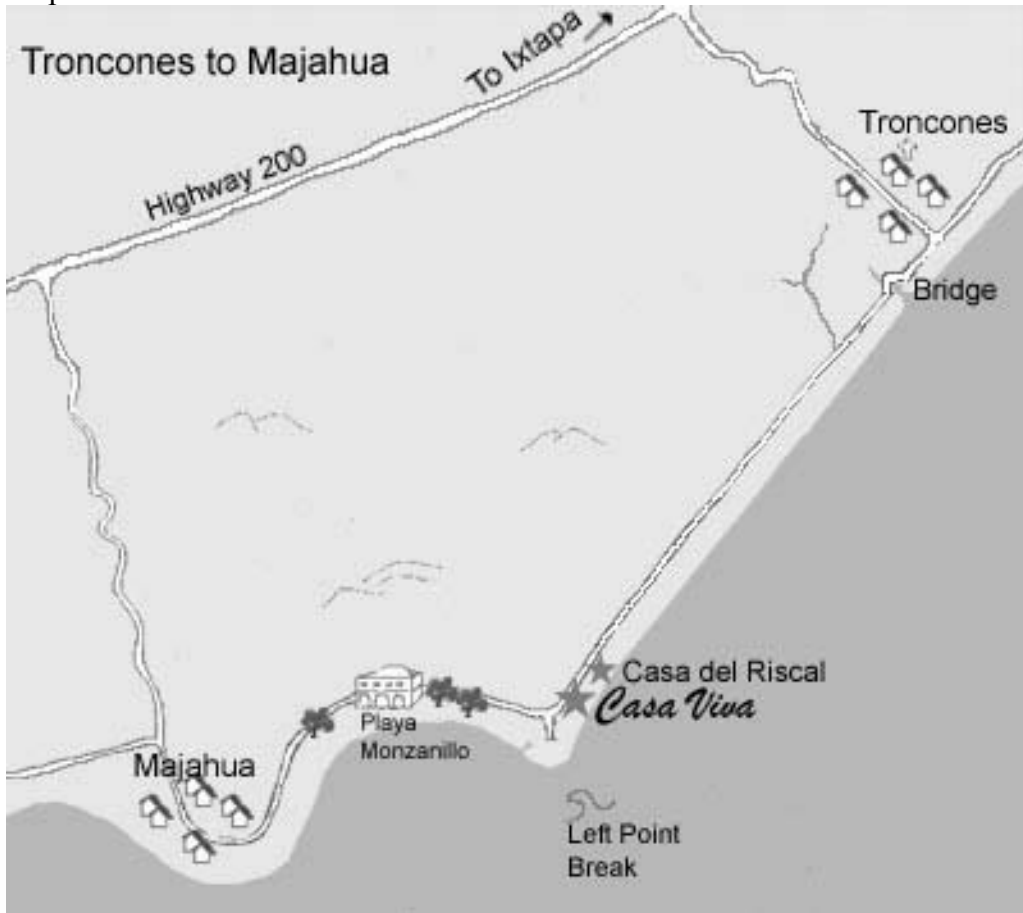
Take the road to Lazaro Cardenas (from Zihuatanejo – towards Ixtapa), you will by-pass Ixtapa and three small pueblos, the last two named Salitera and Buenavista. After Buenavista, on Kilometer marker 31, you will see a small capilla (chapel) and then a sign that says Troncones. Take a left and drive all the way to the Pacific Ocean (T-in road) and make a right (towards Manzanillo Bay), drive about 1 mile. Casa Viva is on your left, right after Casa del Riscal.
